2015 - Trend Reversal or Calm Before the Storm?

Fortunately, the last year did not bring a further increase in new proceedings. The total numbers in the register of proceedings are approximately 5,900 and in the General Register slightly above 8,800 proceedings or new proceedings.

This brief "respite" led to two particularly positive aspects:

Firstly, it enabled both Senates to intensively prepare for the large-scale proceedings concerning the prohibition of the National Democratic Party and the nuclear phase-out and the respective upcoming oral hearings that are scheduled to last several days.

Secondly, for the first time since 2007, the number of proceedings terminated significantly surpassed the number of new proceedings entered into the register of proceedings. Currently, a total of approximately 3,600 proceedings are pending before the Federal Constitutional Court. The very high number of new proceedings brought in the years 2008 to 2014 alone led to a "backlog" of more than 1,000 proceedings not terminated.

This year's total number of proceedings in the register of proceedings is at the level of the year 2012. The following years 2013 and 2014 brought the highest numbers of new proceedings in the Court's history. One can only hope that this development will not repeat itself in the coming years.

Unfortunately, there is nothing to indicate that this decrease in the number of new proceedings marks a real trend reversal that could lead to a significant reduction of the Court's workload. For many years, the number of large-scale, complex proceedings dealt with by the Senates has been very high. Taking a look at the overall political situation in Germany and Europe, it is more likely that, in the near future, the number of proceedings will increase.


