Number of proceedings remains at high level

In 2017 nearly 6,000 new proceedings were recorded, which is an increase of 200 from the year before. The entries in the General Register stayed at previous year's level (8,744).

There has been a noticeable increase in constitutional complaints against court decisions concerning asylum proceedings. While the numbers in the last years ranged between 67 and up to 123 proceedings, the number of constitutional complaints increased to 399 in 2017. A further sharp increase in new proceedings is to be expected in this area in the future.

152 decisions on applications for preliminary injunctions (§ 32 of the Federal Constitutional Court Act) was by far the highest number of the last decades. In this respect it must not be ignored that many of these decisions constitute a particular strain on the Court because of the time pressure involved.

Finally, 2017 brought a true novelty for the Court - a new type of proceedings. Following the judgment on the prohibition of the National Democratic Party of January 2017, Art. 21 of the Basic Law and the Federal Constitutional Court Act were amended.

Under the prerequisites stipulated therein, political parties can now be excluded from state funding. The Federal Constitutional Court decides on applications filed by the *Bundestag*, the *Bundesrat* or the Federal Government. The new proceedings are governed in particular by §§ 13 no. 2a, 43 and 46a of the Federal Constitutional Court Act.

The newly worded Art. 21 of the Basic Law is being challenged by the National Democratic Party of Germany in *Organstreit* proceedings (dispute between constitutional organs) brought against the German *Bundestag* which are presently pending before the Court.




